Here you will be treated to an interactive and enlightening experience with a short film, displays and a ride simulator (don't worry, it's not scary) where you will learn about power generation at the Falls.

Now it's time to experience the power of the Falls up close and personal with a ride on the **Maid of the Mist**. Hear the thundering roar of 600,000 gallons of water falling right before your eyes. Feel the mighty rush of the mist on your face aboard the Maid of the Mist. It's the only way to experience one of the world's most amazing natural wonders right here in the U.S.A.

Before arriving home, a delicious stop will be made at **Platter's Chocolate Factory**. Platter's is taking its chocolate-making to a whole new level by inviting visitors to tour every step of the production. Candy production may not be active during your visit, but you will see the history and machines that produce their famous orange chocolate goodies.
