The dining room offers a picturesque view of the 40 acre vineyard to enhance your experience.

After lunch, finish off your campus visit with a **Guided Winery Tour & Tasting**. A wine expert will lead the group out to the vineyards (weather permitting) to discuss the growing season, terroir and the Canadian wine industry as a whole. Next, make your way into the onsite winemaking facilities where you will learn about the vine-to-bottle journey of their award-winning wines. After the tour, experience a structured tasting of three VQA wines.

Now it's off to a tasty stop Canada's favorite peanut store, **Picard's Peanuts**. You will have the opportunity to sample their products while you browse through the store.
