

**SUMMARY of SUBSTANTIAL AMENDMENTS to  
FY 2020 ANNUAL ACTION PLAN  
and the  
CITIZEN PARTICIPATION PLAN for  
TONAWANDA COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT**

Tonawanda Community Development is proposing Substantial Amendments to the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan and Citizen Participation Plan for Tonawanda’s Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Programs. The amendments establish programming for the special CDBG and ESG appropriations made by the CARES Act to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the COVID-19 crisis.

Citizen Participation Plan amendments are also proposed in order to address executive order restrictions on public gatherings and HUD issued waivers for timely use of the funding. A summary of the amendments for the Citizen Participation Plan are provided on a separate document.

**The Substantial Amendments to the FY 2020 Annual Action Plan include the following revisions:**

1. Increase the FY 2020 CDBG Budget to incorporate \$1,000,784 in Supplemental COVID funds (CDBG-CV) awarded by the CARES Act and allocated according to the following program/budget lines:
