We meet on Thursdays at 7pm at the Lincoln Park Satellite Office, located in Lincoln Park (<https://goo.gl/maps/VzsRxLDccWR2>). This program is FREE of charge and is one of WNY's longest running continuous parental support groups.

- What's discussed at the meeting stays at the meeting

- Pre-Teen through adult children who has loved ones feel they have no one to confide in.
- Looking for support, advice and kinship with those who have shared the same concerns.
- A desire to help others who are experiencing the same problems you have experienced.
- Police Officers are in attendance to serve as facilitators, and give advisement and information from a law enforcement perspective.

Watching your child spiral out of control is scary!

Unfortunately, despite parents' best efforts; it is possible for a teenager or adult child to exhibit some truly terrible and frightening behaviors. An out of control teen or adult child may become verbally or physically abusive, drop out of school, run away from home, or dive into a dark world of drugs and alcohol. The troubled teenager or adult child's aberrant behavior may bring them into contact with law enforcement, and the dreaded spectre of a loved ones' incarceration. Parents may feel hopeless, as they helplessly bear witness to these circumstances, as there is often no quick fix or remedy.
