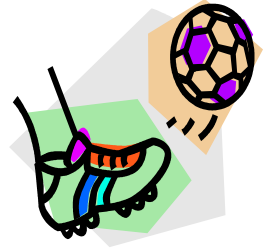




Get Your Kicks Out of Playing Spring Soccer!

***All players are expected to play within their designated age group. Players in the last year of an age group will have the option of playing up one level.**

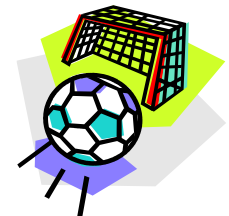
****No Outdoor Travel Players permitted.** Any participants found to be a Travel Player will result in forfeiture of games and player will be asked to leave the program without any refund!
